Academic Calendar

From September 4th 2023, to June 30st 2024

The academic year is divided into two semesters:

***Autumn semester** from September to December or January (depending on the faculty).

***Spring semester** from January to May or June (depending on the faculty) including the teaching and examination periods.

Each faculty determines its own teaching and examination periods.

Integration and welcome days

International exchange students are strongly recommended to attend the free of charge **Integration Seminar** taking place at the end of August (for winter semester and full year) and at the beginning of January (for spring semester).

Program of these integration days: registration, practical information, meetings with students and faculties representatives, discovery of Valenciennes city center and UPHF campus sites, integration activities.

In addition to integration days, the International Office organizes three free of charge cultural and sport activities per semester.

Other Information

FEES	For international exchange students: no fees for tuition, registration, examination and access to facilities such as laboratories, libraries or language centers. For double degree or degree seeking students only : CVEC fees of 100€ (for 2023/2024)
ACCOMMODATION	Accommodation available for international students at 4 halls of residence. Prices wave from 207€ up to 575€* (for 2021/22) per month depending on the size and the equipment of the room. The application for accommodation is included in the UPHF application form.
HEALTH SYSTEM	The EEA members are covered by their European Health Insurance Card. However, for non EEA members, it is compulsory to be affiliated with the "Caisse primaire d'assurance maladie" (social health security scheme for students) in France. Link: https://www.ameli.fr/assure/english-pages
LANGUAGE SUPPORT	During the year: French courses are offered (free of charge) by UPHF during the whole academic year (intermediate and advanced levels). Classes start in September.
