Courses

- Students can choose courses taught in French and/or in English
- Please be aware that there might be some schedule conflicts between courses
- Students are granted a two-week period after the orientation meeting to change their courses
- All courses have quotas, some are submitted to prior assessment of the student's background.

French Language course

Students can enroll for free to the French Language courses [30 hours / semester] and may earn 4ECTS.
Levels from A1 (beginners) to C1 (proficient), determined by a placement test

Grading

We use the 20 points scale in line with the official French grading system.
A grade of 20 represents the highest grade, 0 the lowest and 10 stands for a sufficient achievement.

Living Expenses

This is only an estimate of the costs students will have to support for everyday life : some costs are subjected to change !

Housing fees

University's residences: from 415€ / per month + 15€ electricity

Room or flat in the city: per month = from 350€ (room in the owner's house), from 400€ month (shared apartment), from 550€ (a studio)

Lodging with a host family: from 670€ / month

Private student residence: from 540€ / month

Other expenses

Monthly electricity, gas and telephone bill: 60€ on average

City transport: 25€ for a monthly subscription for the under 25s

Vélov (rent a bike in the city) : 17€ / year
