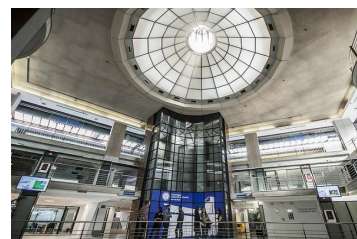

- Minimum: 6 ECTS for Semester / Maximum: 30 ECTS for Semester

- Non European students can select any of the courses from ALL the Schools
