#### Overview

After an introduction to arbitration as a dispute resolution mechanism, the course will focus on various practical issues of international arbitration. Course materials include compulsory readings and case law materials.

- 3. The arbitral proceeding
- 4. Arbitral awards
- 5. Recourse against arbitral awards
- 6. Recognition and enforcement of arbitral awards

## Working method:
