Overview

After a basic introduction to the history, principles and legal sources of international investment law, the course will discuss various issues relating to international investment agreements, the concept of protected investor, the notion of investment, standards of protection, compensation, damages, dispute settlement and arbitration. The course will focus on the practical aspects of international investment law and arbitration. The course materials include mandatory readings and case law materials.

The **outline** of the issues to be covered during the classes is the following:

- 1. Introduction to International Investment Law
- 2. International Investment Agreements
- 3. The Scope of Application of International Investment Agreements
- 4. Standards of Protection
- 5. Restitutions, Damages, Compensation
- 6. Dispute resolution, investment arbitration

Working method

Students are expected to read the materials in advance and discuss them in class. The materials for each class are available on the course Moodle site.

Assessment
