Brief description	The course will review the history of European and Hungarian public administration from its beginnings to the 20 <sup>th</sup> –21 <sup>st</sup> centuries. The focus is on the 19 <sup>th</sup> and 20 <sup>th</sup> centuries, when modern administrative systems were developed. The specificity of the course is that, in addition to the history of the organisation, it deals with the location of administrative bodies: town halls, county halls, ministerial buildings. Accordingly, it shows the space requirements of the organisation, the built and infrastructural conditions under which the administration functioned. The themes also include elements of legal history,
	constitutional history and architectural history.
