Partner institutions receive a link for nomination before the nominations open. After the coordinator submit the nomination, student/students will receive the automatically generated email concerning further steps in the application process.</p>
<p>Nomination process</p>	<p>April 01 – May 15 for first/winter semester and full academic year October 01 – November 15 for second/summer semester</p>
<p>Deadline for applications</p>	<p>June 15 for first/winter semester and full academic year December 15 for second/summer semester</p>
<p>Academic calendar for study period (lectures and seminars) – academic year 2025/26</p>	<p>Winter semester: from September 22, 2025, to December 19, 2025 Summer semester: from February 16, 2026, to May 22, 2026</p>
<p>Academic calendar for exam period – academic year 2025/26</p>	<p>Winter semester: from January 02, 2026, to February 13, 2026 Summer semester: from May 25, 2026, to June 30, 2026</p>

Language requirements	Foreign students must show good command of English (B2) (both written and oral)
Accommodation	Accommodation is not provided to students due to ongoing reconstruction works at the university dormitories.
Special language intensive course	Under Erasmus+ Programme the Slovak language course is free . In order to attend the Slovak language course incoming students have to attend the Welcome Week for Erasmus students, as the first 20 hours are taking place during welcome week and the other 20 hours during semester.
